FBA: Shipments Increase In May

Industry shipments of corrugated products increased 3.9 percent in May, from 30.17 bsf in 2015 to 31.33 bsf in 2016, the Fibre Box Association (FBA) reported. There was one more shipping day in May of 2016.

Average weekly shipments, however, dropped 1.1 percent. Year-to-date shipments at the end of May 2016 increased 1.6 percent.

Containerboard consumption in May increased, from 2.457 million tons in 2015 to 2.542 million tons in 2016, or 3.5 percent. Year-to-date containerboard consumption is up 2.3 percent over 2015.

Containerboard inventories at corrugator plants decreased 3.5 percent from 2.297 million tons in April to 2.215 million tons in May. Weeks of supply decreased from 3.8 to 3.7 or 2.6 percent, from April to May.

Containerboard inventories at box plants and mills posted their largest monthly decline this year, returning to the relatively stable range they had occupied in 2015, noted Dick Storat in his *Scoring Boxes* newsletter.

“Not only did containerboard inventories take a turn for the better, but total U.S. supply chain inventories relative to

Green Bay Packaging Receives PPSA Safety Excellence Award


